## **Caregiver Continuing Education (CCE)**

CCE will continue to build on the learning experienced in Caregiver Core Training (CCT). The four (4) continuing education competencies address specific issues and provide the skills needed to be a successful and on-going caregiver. Caregiver Continuing Education begins immediately upon licensure.

## Required After Licensing Training

- > **So, now you have your first placement.** This training is required to be taken within three months of receiving your first placement.
- All licensees for homes taking placement of Sexually Aggressive or Physically Aggressive Youths must complete **SAY and/or PAY** training. Training is recommended to occur before placement, but must be completed no more than 30 days after placement. Training can be either classroom or on-line.

The four (4) continuing education competency categories identified in the CCE program are:

- Understanding and Teaming with the System
- Working with Children and Families
- Supporting the Caregiver family
- Culturally based training

Several trainings and educational opportunities will be provided within each of these categories by the Alliance for Child Welfare Excellence, including opportunities for on-line learning, classroom learning and blended learning. The following classes have been identified as meeting the new training requirements:

- Understanding and teaming with the system
  - o ICWA
  - Adoption
  - So you Have Your First Placement... Now What?
  - o The paper trail: Documentation Training for Caregivers
  - Teaming with Social Workers
  - Training related to suicide assessment, treatment or screening and referral completed after 1/1/2014.
- Working with Children and Families
  - Working with the Difficult Child
  - o FSAD
  - Sensory Integration

- Parenting a second time around
- African American Hair and Skin Care
- Supporting the Caregiving Family
  - Stress Management
  - Managing Grief
  - o The Effects of Foster Parenting on the Biological Children of Foster Parents
- Culturally Based Training (recommended, but not required)
  - Attendance at a cultural event (attendance must be pre-approved by licensor to be counted as training hours)
  - o Contact your licensor for classes meeting the criteria

## **Caregiver Continuing Training Requirements**

All licensed caregivers are required to complete Caregiver Continuing Education courses as follows.

- > During the first 3-year licensing period:
  - 36 hours of Caregiver Continuing Education that includes at least one course from each of the three (3) Competency Categories
  - o Cultural based training is not required

- Second consecutive 3-year licensing period:
  - 30 hours of Continuing Education training that includes at least one course from each of the Three Competency Categories
- All subsequent consecutive licensing periods
  - 24 hours of Continuing Education from any of the four Competency Categories.
- ➤ BRS Foster Homes must complete 30 hours of training per year (90 hours during 3 year license period.) There is no reduction in training hours in subsequent licenses.

The agency licensing department is required to work with each foster home to create a training plan. DLR and agency licensors have the option to require specific and/or additional training as part of a training or compliance plan.

One or both parties on a license may meet CCE requirements. That is, one party on a two party license may complete all required training hours or two people on a two party license may each complete part of the required hours as long as the total number of hours meets the requirement. (However, it is recommended that each party on a two party license complete some training.) If training hours exceed the

required number of hours, up to twelve (12) hours can be carried over to the next license period.
